### **About the Festival**

Danceworks SHINE #1 is part of the Danceworks festival series, organized by Alberta dance instructor Rhonda Heald, who has over 40 years of experience hosting dance festivals in Red Deer, Alberta. This festival is dedicated to creating a positive and enjoyable experience for studios, teachers, dancers, and parents.

### Awards:

- Medals are awarded to all participants.
- Additional achievement awards include Outstanding (1st), Rising Star (2nd), Shining Star (3rd), X Factor, Adjudicator's Choice, and Choreography Awards.
- Special awards may be presented at the adjudicator's discretion for routines that demonstrate exceptional star quality.

## **Adjudication:**

Performances are evaluated by experienced adjudicators based on dance curriculum, technique, and artistry.

# **Festival Rules & Expectations**

1. Arrival & Check-in

- Dancers must arrive **1.5 hours before** their scheduled performance.
- Report directly to the warm-up area with your class and instructors.
- o Avoid wandering or entering the theatre before your performance.

# 2. **Dressing Room Etiquette**

- Arrive with hair and makeup **already done** due to limited dressing room space.
- Parents and dancers are responsible for all costumes and accessories.
- o Do **not** eat in costumes and keep them neatly hung.

## 3. Dress Code & Cover-ups

- o Cover-ups must be worn outside the dressing room to protect costumes.
- o MYD clothing is recommended for showing studio support.

## 4. Awards & Attendance

- Dancers should stay for **award presentations** to support their peers.
- o Watching other performances is encouraged but not mandatory.

## 5. Nutrition & Hydration

- o Eat **healthy foods** such as proteins and complex carbohydrates.
- o Avoid sugary and junk food to maintain energy levels.

# 6. Responsibility & Independence

- o Teachers will be busy, so dancers must be responsible for their own warm-ups and rehearsals.
- o Do **not** wander outside designated areas.

# **Backstage & Theatre Policies**

- Backstage Access: Dancers may enter two routines before their performance and must exit immediately after. No parents backstage.
- **Photography & Videography:** Strictly prohibited. Violators risk **disqualification**.
- Tap Shoes: Only allowed backstage—not in hallways or warm-up areas.
- Valuables: Avoid bringing valuable items as the festival is not responsible for lost or stolen property.

## **Code of Conduct**

- 1. Dancers must conduct themselves **professionally** and treat others with **respect**.
- 2. Negative comments about other dancers, studios, costumes, or adjudicators are **not tolerated**.

- 3. Treat parents, teachers, and fellow dancers with **kindness and appreciation**.
- 4. Encourage and support each other—we are all part of the same team.

**Note:** Unsportsmanlike conduct may result in disqualification.

# **Costume, Hair & Makeup Guidelines**

## 1. Makeup

- o Foundation matching skin tone, set with powder.
- o Brown-toned eyeshadow, black eyeliner, and mascara.
- o Deep plum-burgundy lipstick (no red or pink tones).

## 2. **Hair:**

- Acro, Ballet, Lyrical & Contemporary: Middle Part Slicked Back into a Low Bun
- o **Tap & Jazz:** Middle Part Slicked Back into a Low Ponytail
- o **Hip Hop:** Middle Part Slicked Back into Low Pigtails.
- o Use hairspray to secure hair and avoid loose strands.

#### 3. Accessories

- o No nail polish or jewelry.
- o Proper **undergarments** must be worn.
- o Pack extra **tights** to avoid issues with rips or holes.

## **Festival Checklist**

### Makeup Bag:

- Makeup remover & nail polish remover
- Foundation, blush, eyeshadow (browns/white), eyeliner, mascara
- Eyelashes & glue (optional), lipstick, lip liner
- Brushes & applicators
- Hair supplies (hairspray, gel, brush, comb, elastics, pins, hairnet)
- Small sewing kit, safety pins, band-aids, deodorant

### Dance Bag:

- All dance shoes
- Tights (plus extra pairs)
- Socks (if required)
- Appropriate undergarments
- Water bottle & healthy snacks
- Ouiet activities for downtime
